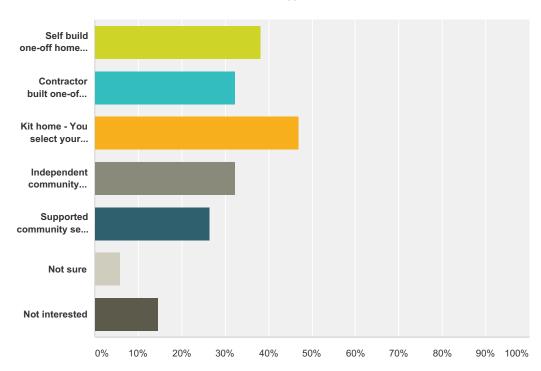
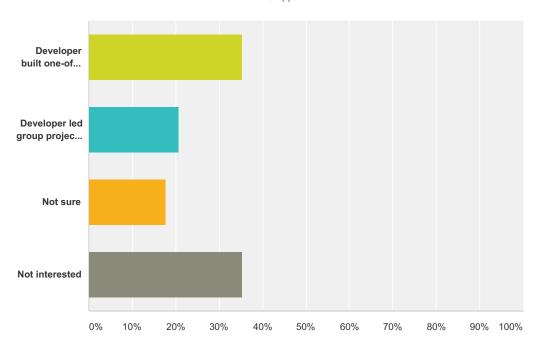
Q1 What is Self Build Housing? There are a range of options for a self build housing project. Tick the options below that you might be interested in.





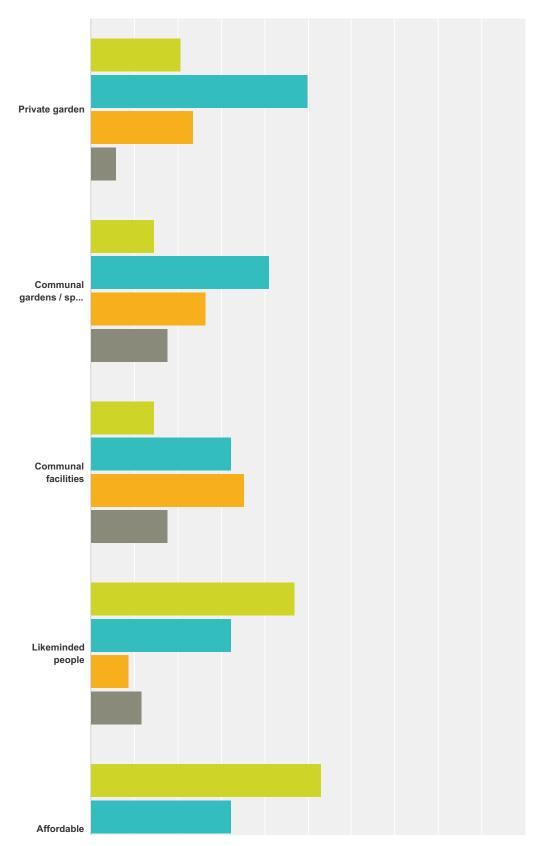

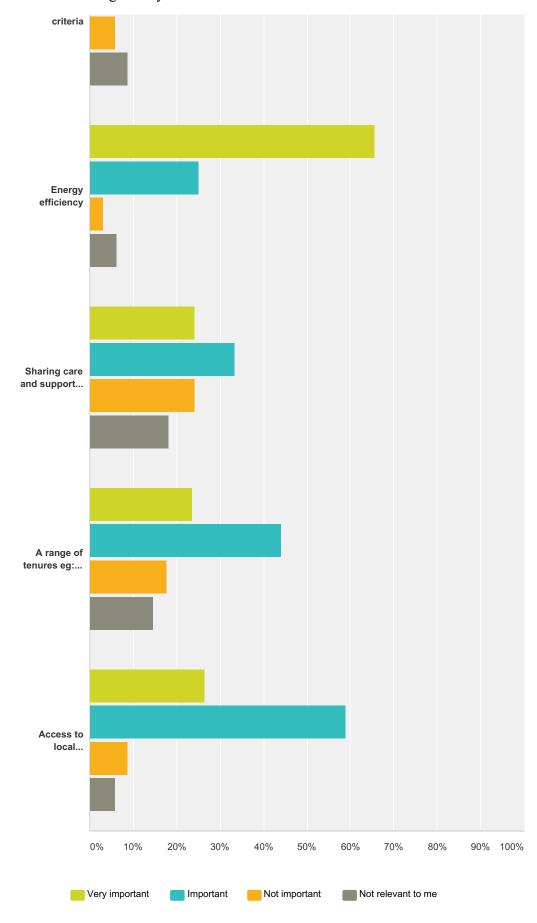

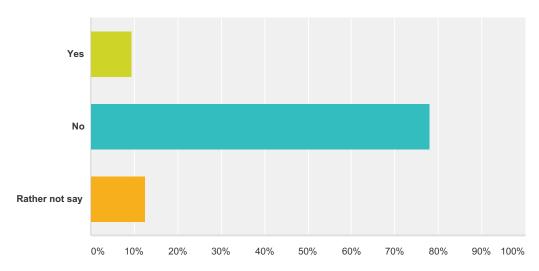
Q5 Do you see yourself now or in the future having some physical support needs which could be met by living in a co-operative housing environment. Would you be interested in this option?

Q6 Can you suggest any suitable land for a self build or custom build housing project in Gillingham Parish?



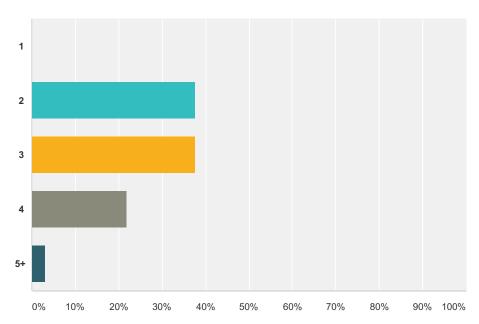

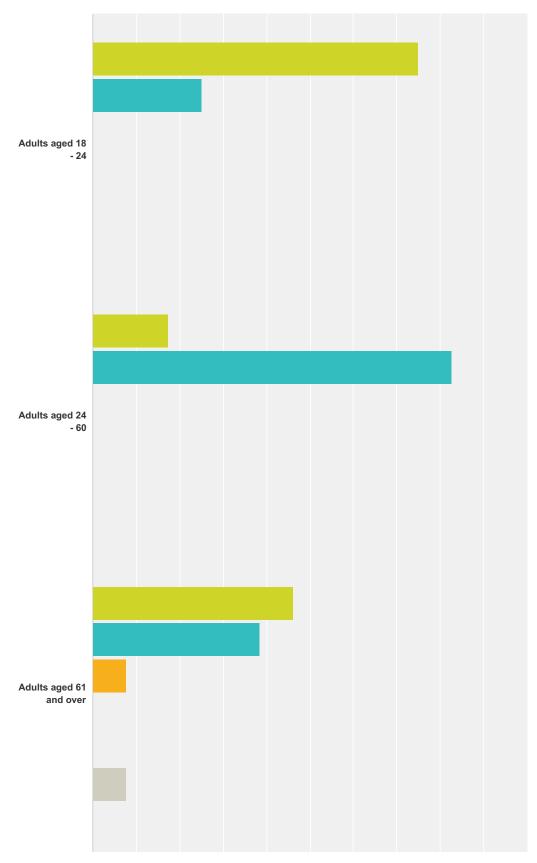
Q7 How many bedrooms would you require for your house?

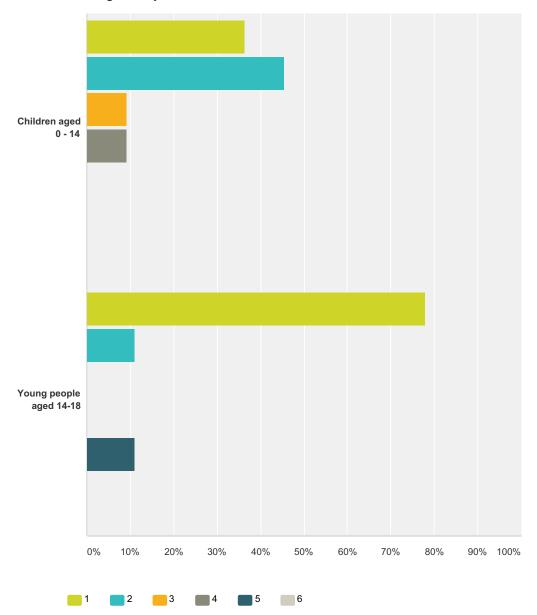

Q8 To help understand the mix of housing, please tell us the mix of adults and children.



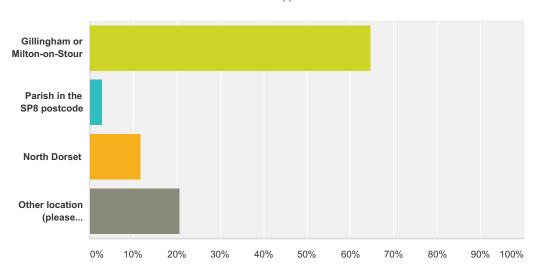

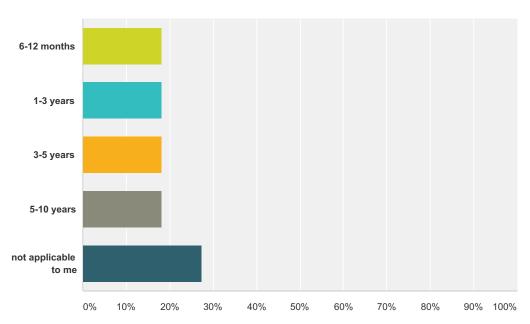

Q10 What time period are you looking at for a self or custom build housing?

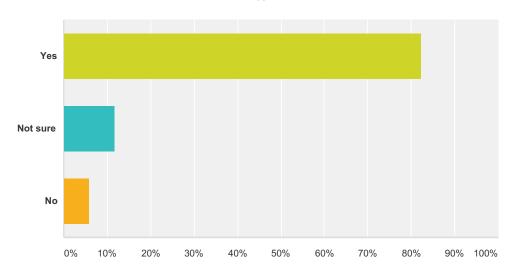
