





Submission of Plans to the Secretary of State: Bournemouth, Dorset and Poole Waste Plan Bournemouth, Dorset and Poole Mineral Sites Plan

Dorset County Council gives notice under Regulation 22 of the Town and Country Planning (Local Planning) (England) Regulations 2012 that the Bournemouth, Dorset and Poole Waste Plan and the Bournemouth, Dorset and Poole Mineral Sites Plan were submitted to the Secretary of State for Communities and Local Government on 29 March 2018 for independent examination.
