Ref North Dorset Local Plan, Policy 21 in Document MHD050, issue July 2015.

The 'Shaftesbury Road Corridor (Local Centre)' is unexplained in Pages 19 - 21 other than a star on the map contained in that section.

Traffic flow at peak, and now often non- peak times renders this road at a standstill with over half a mile of traffic queue, for up to 3 hours a day. The proposed Southern extension to Gillingham, will add the traffic from 2200 houses onto this road without any proposals to add additional roads to avoid this gridlock.

NO development should be considered without a Community Infrastructure Levy on the developers to provide a ring road to take traffic from the current Sydmonds roundabout on the Shaftesbury Road to take traffic via Madjeston around to connect to Peacemarsh, thus eliminating a significant proportion of the traffic thru the town.
