How much, if any, funding has the LAP levered in to deliver projects?	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • £15,000 has been raised from grant support for the Bridport Area Neighbourhood Plan. Although administered by Bridport Town Council, this project was initiated by BLAP, and partnership support was essential for a successful funding application. • £2,400 has been awarded to the Bridport Collaboration project – a partnership initiative by BLAP and 6 member organisations. An application is currently being drafted for a further £15,000 from the Arts Council of England, who have given informal indications of support. • Approx. £1,000 has been foregone by providers of venues for BLAP meetings and events.
