I consider the plan to increase the number of houses within the town unsound. The crown meadows are too central for development. They are on a flood plain and as recently witnessed due to the winter storms unsuitable for housing development due to the high water table. The meadows are a unique feature of Blandford and enhance the beauty of a georgian market town which regionally has no rival. The proposed development would incur significant changes to the infrastructure needed to cope with greater population numbers in particular the provision of schooling, traffic access, and medical resources, all of which are close to or at full capacity. Apart from the emotive reaction against the vandalism of a beautiful part of the town there are real concerns about the viability of such a project. The majority of local residents do not want this proposed development and are in favour of an alternative site which would not have such profound impact, and which would be more suitable for development. Opposition to the crown meadows development will increase as local people see their wishes run roughshod over by blinkered short term gain.
