Thank you for providing National Highways with the opportunity to comment on the first review, submission version of the Pimperne Neighbourhood Plan. National Highways is responsible for operating, maintaining and improving the strategic road network (SRN) which in this case comprises the A303 and A31 trunk roads which pass some distance to the north and south respectively of the plan area. We are therefore satisfied that the Plan's proposed policies are unlikely to result in development which will adversely impact the safe and efficient operation of the SRN and we therefore have no comments to make.

This does not however prejudice any future responses National Highways may make on site specific applications as they come forward through the planning process, and which will be considered by us on their merits under the prevailing policy at the time.
