Figure 7 and 8 show the slight slope down to Shreen Water, from the footpath that runs from Barnaby Mead. The rooftops of the Barnaby Mead bungalows are visible in figure 7. The white constriction offices highlight the impact that two storey development is likely to have on this part of the area. The skyline is currently formed by the combination of existing buildings and the higher ground that surrounds Gillingham. The addition of a strong line of new development will have a significant effect.

Around the edges of the site, the blurring effect of the hedges and trees is shown. Although the buildings are still visible, their impact is reduced.
