

## **Standard Conditions of Street Consent Licence**

1. The trader shall only trade from locations highlighted on the Licence Plan(s) attached to the Consent.
2. The trader shall only trade between the dates and times as indicated on the Consent.
3. The Consent shall not be transferable to any other person not named on the Consent.
4. Any requests of Dorset Police, Dorset Fire and Rescue Services and Dorset Council's Food, Health and Safety Sections shall be complied with in full.
5. All traders, or a coordinator of such, shall obtain prior permission of the Highways Authority's 'Road Space' Section to occupy public highway.
6. All traders shall be covered by a minimum of £5,000,000 public liability insurance, have such certificate with them whilst trading, and make available such certificate upon request to any representative of Dorset Council, Dorset Police or Dorset Fire and Rescue Service,
7. All traders shall leave the licensed area in a clean and tidy condition and shall be responsible for the cleansing of streets, including the removal of litter, and ensuring stains from any spilled fluids etc on pavements/roads during their events etc are removed.
8. Traders should ensure that no substances are poured down the surface drains.
9. The areas marked as '1' and '2' on the plan, as attached to the Consent, shall be kept clear at all times for access of emergency vehicles in the events of an emergency.
10. Within any licensed area comprising of public highway there shall be a minimum of 3.7 metres kept clear of stalls or other 'street furniture' at all times.
11. No stall, or any related 'furniture' shall be located on a pavement in front of any business premises open to the public
12. No stall shall be located adjacent to the entrance of a business premises, being open to the public, that sells articles that is the main type of goods sold in those adjacent business premises.
13. There shall be a clear space between each stall to minimise the risk of spread of fire.
14. There shall be no cooking of food on the Events area of the Square at any time.
15. Traders, or coordinator of such, shall have undertaken a risk assessment of their trading and make available the assessment upon request to any representative of Dorset Council, Dorset Police or Dorset Fire and Rescue Service.
