Section 4 of the plan specifically refers to Burton Farm which will disappear after 120 years (4 generations). I would ask that the Inspector considers this in conjunction with the farm tenancy clauses referred to in previous reports from Jacksons.

I would also refer the Inspector to the 1600 signature petition delivered to a Christchurch Council Meeting, which gets a very small mention! This is only the tip on the iceberg, we just ran out of time. Burton residents feel very strongly about not allowing this to happen.
